**COUNTY OF ANDERSON, TEXAS
AMENDED NUMBER OF SHOPPERS ORDER**

WHEREAS, a Declaration of Local Disaster was issued on March 19, 2020, for Anderson County due to a novel Coronavirus, now designated SARS-COV2 which causes the disease COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, the Commissioners Court of Anderson County affirmed the Declaration of Local Disaster for Anderson County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 418.108, the County Judge may enter such orders as may be necessary to protect the safety and welfare of the public during a local disaster; and

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Number of Shoppers Order is hereby amended that mass retailers, such as, but not limited to Grocery Stores, Supermarkets, Dollar Stores, Wal-Mart, Lowes, McCoy's and Tractor Supply, limit the number of family members coming in to shop, when at all possible, to 1 adult family member at a time. This order does not apply to single parents who have no one to keep their children, adults who need a caregiver with them for support, and other special circumstances that may arise.

THIS ORDER SHALL BE in effect until it is either rescinded, superseded, or amended pursuant to applicable law.
