The Commissioners Court of Anderson County, Texas, will meet to consider and approve a proposed tax abatement agreement pursuant to and as authorized by the Property Redevelopment and Tax Abatement Act, that being Chapter 312 of the Tax Code, (the "Act") for a certain parcel of real property, that being approximately three (3) acres located within the Willow Creek Business Park Reinvestment Zone No. 1 (the "**Tax Abatement Agreement**").

Mallard Street, Palestine, Texas, 75801, at which time the Commissioners Court shall consider and approve the proposed Tax Abatement Agreement pursuant to Section 312.206 of the Act.
