How to Sign up for Inmate Visitation

1. Using a computer, tablet or smart phone, visit the web site at <https://scheduler.tarmactech.com>.
2. There is a tablet available in the lobby of the Jail to access the website.
3. Select the inmate you wish to visit and choose the available date and time.
4. Enter the required information and confirm.

Rules to Follow for Your Visit

1. All visitors **must** be on the inmate's approved visitation list.
2. Each inmate is allowed two 20-minute visits per week.
3. Up to three visitors are allowed to visit at one time.
4. All personal items should be secured in your vehicle during the visit.
5. Cameras, cellphones, handbags, and baby carriers are not allowed in the visitation area.
6. **Check in is 20 minutes prior to the scheduled visit.** If late, access will be denied.
7. Visits are 20 minutes in duration. A visit may not be divided/rotated between visitors.
8. If a visitor exits the visitation area, the visit is terminated. There is no reentry.
9. Visitors sixteen (16) years or older must have a valid government-issued photo ID such as a Driver License, State- issued ID card, or passport. The photo ID must match the ID information entered on the visitation website.
10. Minors **under** sixteen (16) must be accompanied by an adult on the approved visitation list.
11. Minors fifteen (15) years of age or younger are not required to be on the visitation list.
12. The visitation area is a **SECURE AREA**.
13. If you have any contraband (see below), please take it out of the facility immediately.
 - a. **Contraband includes but is not limited to:** Alcohol, Tobacco or Tobacco products, E-vapes, Matches, Lighters, or any flammable substance, Firearms or ammunition. Knife or sharp-edge items, Cash, Money. Prescriptions or non-prescription medications or drugs

The Anderson County Jail is Not Responsible for Unattended Items/Property

Disruptive behavior or a violation of the visitation rules is grounds for termination of the visit and removal from that inmate's visitation list.
