I am not a U.S. citizen and am ineligible to vote in this election.

The State Mass Mail-Out of voter certificates has been delayed this year due to converting over to a new voter registration system and redistricting in several counties. All eligible & active voters will receive a [New Orange Voter Certificate](#) as soon as the State sends the approved voter file to each County. The Secretary of State is working diligently on resolving the delay as each county is unique and will receive its Voter Registration file for MAILING in due time. Please be patient.

We have also approached a very busy election season, which will also delays the process.

- **Voters:** You do not need a new voter card to vote in the 2026 Primary Election or any other upcoming election.
- **All voters** must bring one of the 7 approved acceptable forms of photo identifications to all voting locations.
- **Acceptable Forms** of Photo ID include the following below:
 - Texas Driver's License**
 - Texas Personal ID**
 - Texas ID Certificate**
 - Texas Handgun License**
 - US Passport**
 - US Citizenship with Photo ID**
 - US Military ID**

If you do not possess an acceptable form of photo identification and cannot reasonably obtain one, you may present a [supporting form of ID](#) (one of which is your valid voter registration certificate) and execute a [Reasonable Impediment Declaration \(PDF\)](#), noting your reasonable impediment to obtaining an acceptable form of photo identification, stating that the information contained in the declaration is true, that you are the same individual personally appearing at the polling place to sign the declaration, and that you face a reasonable impediment to procuring an acceptable form of photo identification. An election official will match your name to the official list of registered voters.

- copy or original of a government document that shows the voter's name and an address, including the voter's voter registration certificate;
- copy of or original current utility bill;
- copy of or original bank statement;
- copy of or original government check;
- copy of or original paycheck; or
- copy of or original of (a) a certified domestic (from a U.S. state or territory) birth certificate or (b) a document confirming birth admissible in a court of law which establishes the voter's identity (which may include a foreign birth document).

After presenting one of the forms of supporting ID listed above, the voter must execute a Reasonable Impediment Declaration.
